
Owner in the country running his own club, (The one man bogus club). There's that word again - bogus. Oh no! I've caught the Clarke Jones bogus mania bug!!

The cheapest way to do this conversion, is to buy a complete Granada.

# You'll need the following:

Carb or injection system (if anyone's feeling brave), clutch, manifold, exhaust downpipes, complete electronic ignition system, alternator, starter motor and ignition coil.

From the Taunus you will need: Engine mounts, complete throttle linkage, starter motor, alternator (P5 - dynamo), sump, oil pump strainer intake pipe, radiator, hoses, distributor and ignition coil, (2.3 & 2.6 - complete clutch), and the clutch release bearing.

Once you've got both engines out of both cars, then you can start the conversion. I suggest you drop your Taunus gearbox to make life easier. (You don't have to but it's a bit of a struggle dropping the engine into the bay and onto the box at the same time).

First thing is to take the Taunus sump and oil pump strainer intake pipe and fit them to the Granada engine, (these parts can only go on one way and all sump gaskets are the same). The I.8 and 2.0 V6's will have to use the Granada clutch plates and cover - keep the original release bearing. 2.3 and 2.6 Taunus clutches should be the same diameter and size as the Granada, but check before fitting.

Drop the engine into the bay onto the Taunus engine mounts, then put the gearbox back on (if dropped), everything bolts into place. You can either use the Granada or Taunus starter motor, they both have the same number of teeth. If you use the Granada alternator, you'll have to have it wired up to your relay box. If you use the Taunus alternator, you'll need to make a bracket. If you use the Granada alternator on a P5, you will need to have the electrics changed from 6 volts to I2 volts.

If you want to keep the electronic ignition system, you'll have to have it wired up and change the coil, but you can use your original Taunus ditributor. Connect up the throttle linkage to the carb, refit your radiator and hoses, refit your heater hoses (you may have to swop these over from left to right). The fan pully on the Granada has a spacer between the blades — you don't need it. P5 Taunus's will have to have radiator hoses made up and joined with a piece of metal tubing, you can buy flexible rad hose from custom shops.

Fit your Granada downpipes to the manifold, you'll probably have to have these welded to your existing exhaust system or you can use the Granada exhaust and replace the mounts or make them up. The I.8 and 2.0 V6's will have to uprate the back axle using a Taunus 2.3 or 2.6 diff or even fit 15" wheels.

(All gearboxes are the same ratio in top gear).

Anybody who has any problems with this conversion - let me know. If you're really brave - go for the 2.8 or 2.9 injection and let me know how you get on.
